

Geographical Coordinates of Some Features Related to Egan Clan Reunions

Copy the latitude and longitude as given below and enter into the 'Search the map' input of Google Maps. Then click "Search Maps" and adjust the zoom (reduce until satellite view is available).

"Current Resolution" refers to the distance currently given on the Google Maps map scale marker and is an indication of how well features can be seen in the satellite view. Currently, 20 ft. resolution is available at some places (for example, in San Francisco, CA). With this resolution, features as small as a garbage can at the curb can be identified and "STOP" painted on a street can be easily read. The best resolution in the list below, 100 ft., permits buildings and fields to be seen and possibly identified (see Gallway Cathedral at N 53 16 29.8, W 9 3 26.7 for another example of 100 foot resolution). The 2000 ft. resolution allows a building to barely be seen but not identified. Hopefully the resolutions will improve in the future, in which case the coordinates will be of more value.

The indicated accuracy of the recording was usually 10 to 20 feet.
